

# Soak-Eze Liquid

## Flatware Presoak and Silver Tarnish Remover

Product Number 4431

### Description

A unique liquid product designed to pre-soak and de-tarnish at the same time. Helps to soften and solubilize food soils and allow for proper mechanical cleaning. Safe on all kitchen flatware, silverware, and utensils. Can also be used to soak and clean filters from oven hoods.

### Directions

To pre-soak, use a shallow plastic tray. For silver tarnish removal, place a piece of aluminum foil to cover bottom surface of soaking tray. Mix 1 - 2 ounces of product per 2 gallons of warm to hot water. Make sure product has thoroughly dissolved. Place flatware/silverware into tray and allow to soak for several minutes. Remove flatware and rinse before placing into normal dishwashing rack. Wash as usual.

#### DANGER

**EYES:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention. Call a poison control center or physician for treatment advice. **IF**

**INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Store locked up. Dispose contents/containers to trash after rinsing container.
